- Read verse 35. What does Jesus promise, and what does he mean? How does he rebuke them (36)? What is his faith (37)? What does he say about the Father's will (38–40)? What can we learn about Jesus here?
- 4. How do the Jews respond (41–42)? Who are those who truly come to Jesus, and what does this mean (43–45)? What is unique about him, and what does he promise (46–47)?
- 5. How does Jesus contrast himself with the manna (48–51)? How do the Jews react (52)? What does it mean to eat his flesh and drink his blood, and why must we (53–58)?
- 6. How do many respond (60)? What does Jesus say, especially about his words (61–66)? What does he ask the Twelve, and why (67)? What does Simon Peter say, and how is he a good example for all believers (68–69)? What is Jesus' final warning, and why does he say this (70–71)?
