Luke 18:35-43

Key Verse: 42 "And Jesus said to him, 'Recover your sight; your faith has made you well.'"

1. As Jesus drew near to Jericho, who was by the roadside and what was he doing (35)? Whom might the man represent? (cf. 18:34; 2Co 4:4)
2. Upon hearing a crowd passing by, what did the man do and why (36)? How did the crowd answer his inquiry (37)? What did the man do (38)? Why did the crowd rebuke him (39a)? When rebuked, what did he do and why (39b)? What did he believe about Jesus?
3. How did Jesus respond to his pleas (40)? What question did Jesus ask him and why (41a)? What was this man's one clear request to Jesus (41b)? What one thing do you desire Jesus to do for you?
4. How did Jesus bless him (42a)? What else did Jesus declare to him (42b; 17:19b)? What happened to him (43a)? What did the man and the crowd do (43b)? What can we learn about Jesus in this passage? (cf. 4:17-21) About faith? About how to recover our spiritual sight? (cf. 24:44-45; 2Co 4:6)
