TRUE GREATNESS

Luke 9:37-50 Key Verse: 9:48

"Then he said to them, 'Whoever welcomes this little child in my name welcomes me; and whoever welcomes me welcomes the one who sent me. For it is the one who is least among you all who is the greatest."

- 1. When Jesus and three disciples came back, what did they encounter (37-39)? Describe the father's agony. How did this contrast the scene on the mountain? How had the other disciples who had not gone with Jesus failed (40)?
- 2. How does Jesus' lament reveal the root problem of that generation (41a)? How does Jesus' lament express the heart and mind of God? How did Jesus heal the boy (41b-42)? How did the people react to this (43a)?
- 3. While everyone was marveling, what did Jesus tell his disciples to listen to carefully and why (43b-44)? What did the disciples think of Jesus' words (45)?
- 4. What did the disciples argue about, and how does this reveal their underlying desire (46)? What did Jesus know about them, and how did he demonstrate true greatness (47-48)? Where does true greatness come from? How is this related to the way of Jesus' cross?
- 5. What was John's problem (49)? How does Jesus' response reveal his kingdom mindset (50)? What has this passage shown you about being great in God's judgment?
