- 2. How does Paul explain our resurrection (21–22)? What does it mean to be "in Christ" (Ro6:5; Gal2:20)? How are we made alive in Christ both now (Ro8:11; Eph2:5–6; Col2:12–13) and in the future (see verses 51–53)?
- 3. What else does Paul point out (23), and why does he emphasize "order"? What does "his coming" mean?
- 4. What will the Risen Christ ultimately do (24)? What are "every rule, authority and power," and what can we learn here about Christ? What Scripture does Paul quote (25; Ps110:1), and how does this give us hope? What is the last enemy (26)?
- 5. What is the final outcome of the resurrection, what is repeated here, and why (25–28)?
