LOOK, THE LAMB OF GOD John 1:19-34 Key Verse: 1:29

1. Read verses 19-22. Where was John and what was he doing? (28) Who came to question John? Where did they come from?

2. Who did they think he might be? What did he confess freely to them? What questions did they ask him? What three negative answers did he give? Why did he answer like this?

3. Read verse 23. What did John finally say about himself? What was his mis¬sion? What does it mean that he identifies himself with the quotation of Isaiah?

4. Read verses 24-28. What else did those who were sent ask? What was John's answer to them? How did he seek to point them to Jesus? (Read verse 31. Why did John baptize?) What can we learn from this man of mission?

5. Read verse 29. The next day, when John saw Jesus, how did he introduce him? What does this mean? (See Ex 29:38; 12:3,7,13; 1Co 5:7; Heb 9:14) How does Jesus take away the sin of the world?

6. Read verses 30-34. How did John come to recognize Jesus and become the first witness? (32,33) Summarize John's testimony about Jesus. (29,30,33,34)
